On the Map

New Zealand is a nation made up of many islands, but most people live on the two largest. In English, these are called North Island and South Island. These names have been on maps since the 1800s, when many British people started living there. However, a different group of people, called the Maori, have been living in New Zealand (36). They already had their own names for the islands.

The Maori people first arrived in New Zealand around 900 years ago, and they have their own culture and language. The Maori name for North Island is Te Ika-a-Maui, which means “the fish of the hero Maui.” South Island, on the other hand, is called Te Waipounamu, which means “the waters of the greenstone.” The Maori names were sometimes written on maps until the 1950s. However, after that they (37). This is probably because English was the only official language at that time, and most people called the islands by their English names.

However, the New Zealand government made the Maori language into an official language in 1987. Then, in 2013, the government discovered that the islands had never been given official names. They asked the people of New Zealand which pair of names they wanted as the official names for the islands. Most people said that they liked the idea of having both pairs. The government decided to (38) the people’s idea. From now on, new maps of New Zealand will have the English names and the Maori names written on the islands.

The Marathon of Hope

Terry Fox was born in the Canadian city of Winnipeg in 1958. As a teenager, he loved sports, and his dream was to become a P.E. teacher. However, in 1977, Fox's life changed forever. Doctors found bone cancer in his right knee, and they had to remove his leg in order to keep the cancer from moving to other parts of his body. Fox was only 18 years old.

While Fox was in the hospital, he met many other cancer patients. He saw that they were suffering very much, so he wanted to do something to help them. When Fox received a metal leg from the hospital, he decided to run across Canada with his new leg to raise money for cancer research. Fox told the Canadian Cancer Society what he hoped to do, and they supported his run, which was named the Marathon of Hope.

After training for over a year, Fox began his run on April 12, 1980, on the eastern coast of Canada. As Fox ran west and gained more attention, more and more money was given to his run. On September 1, 1980, after running for 143 days and 5,373 kilometers, Fox felt a pain in his chest and had to quit. He went to the hospital, and the doctors found that his cancer had moved to his lungs. Fox died on June 28, 1981. He had run about halfway across Canada.

Although Fox died before he could reach his goal of running all the way across Canada, he was able to give hope to cancer patients all around the world. Fox's story became famous, and a race called the Terry Fox Run has been held every year since 1981. Today, over 30 countries worldwide hold their own Terry Fox Run, and over \$600 million has been raised for cancer research.
